Typically, a baby grows in the womb for 40 weeks before being born Babies born at 40 weeks are called full-term If a baby is born earlier than 37 weeks, that baby is called premature, or preterm or a "preemie" In the US 12-13% of infants are born premature What Causes Babies to ...

#### Premature Babies: Contributing Factors, Problems and Need ...

Premature baby refers to a newborn baby or an infant with Low Birth Weight (LBW) Conventionally, definition of premature is referring to the birth prior to 37-week pregnancy In medical terms and according to WHO, premature infants are the babies born before the 37th week of pregnancy (Turner-Maffei et al, 2014)

#### PREMATURITY AWARENESS

A premature or preterm baby is a baby born before 37 completed weeks of pregnancy An average pregnancy is 40 weeks, so a premature baby is born at least 3 weeks early Prematurity is a serious health problem for Maryland and for the nation Babies born too soon can have lifelong or life-threatening health problems

#### **Introducing solids to premature babies**

As with full-term babies, the later a premature baby is introduced to new tastes and textures the less likely they are to accept them Babies need to explore, touch and taste new food at their own pace Offer your baby a spoon at mealtimes even if you continue to feed them with another spoon Start

## Lung disease in premature babies

Premature babies need oxygen and breathing support for weeks after birth Their lungs gradually improve as they grow, but if a premature baby still needs additional support by the time they are the equivalent of 36 weeks of gestation we call this Chronic Lung Disease of Prematurity The medical term for this is Bronchopulmonary Dysplasia or BPD

When a baby is born prematurely, they will immediately be taken to a special care baby unit (Neonatal Intensive Care Unit), so that a specialised healthcare team can provide individualised care This can be very distressing for parents as they are separated from their baby so soon after birth, in addition to their baby arriving unexpectedly early
