The number of prisoners under state and federal jurisdiction at year-end 2016 (1,506,800) was a 7% decrease (down 108,700 prisoners) from 2009 when the US prison population peaked (table 1) Federal prisoners made up 13% of the total US prison population at year-end 2016 but accounted for 37% of the decline in the total prison population The
